on
Disability and Reasonable Accommodation Policy

Thammasat University is committed to full inclusion of people with disabilities to maximize their ability and opportunity for full participation at Thammasat University. Pursuant to the Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities Act, B.E. 2550 (2007), Thammasat University hereby issues the following policy on disability and reasonable accommodation:

1. In this announcement “people with disabilities” are defined as people who have limitations in performing daily activities or participating in social functions due to physical, intellectual, learning, or any other impairments and require special assistance to perform daily activities or participate in social functions.
2. Relevant sectors shall strictly follow the guideline to provide reasonable accommodations to people with disabilities to ensure equal employment opportunities and access to University’s programs, services, and facilities according to Thammasat University Notification on Disability and Reasonable Accommodation Policy.
3. Relevant sectors shall build and facilitate individual plans for reasonable accommodations for faculty, staff, and students with disabilities, as well as link them with technology, education, and resources.
4. Departments and faculties shall ensure that the work environment, programs, course instruction, course materials, and events are accessible to faculty, staff, and students with disabilities.

5. New construction and renovation projects on the premises of the University shall meet national accessibility standards and, if possible, strive towards the principles of universal design to achieve an environment that is both accommodating and user-friendly.
